



## Dr. Agata Stepien

Born in Cracov 1986 into a family of polish artists, she grew up in Spain. She spent the last 12 years studying visual arts in Poland, Spain, Belgium, Portugal and Italy (obtaining scholarship in 4 countries.)

She obtained a master's degree in art at the Academy of Fine Arts in Rome (diploma in painting with honors), after which she moved to Barcelona and completed her doctoral studies there obtaining a doctorate in international art at two universities: Universidad Castilla La Mancha in Spain and simultaneously Universidade Belas Artes Lisboa in Portugal in 2016.

In the years 2017-2021, she directed bilingual courses of which she is the author: Global perspective of the body in current art. The introductory themes in vision of gender phenomena, "Transgression in art – Cultural Dynamic" at the Faculty of Humanities of the AGH University of Sciences and Technology in Krakow.

Among the events planned for 2021 is the exhibition in the Library of the Jagiellonian University "loneliness in culture", where her works will be presented along with works by artists such as Rembrandt and Nikifor, and a solo exhibition at the prestigious Anotonio Perez de Cuenca Museum, where one of the works will remain in the permanent collection of the Museum in 2021.

Agata Stepien cooperates with European galleries. Her works have been presented in the following museums: Capitoline Museums in Rome during the exhibition of the Academy of Fine Arts, San Salvadore di Lauro Museum in Rome San Jose Women's Museum, Costa Rica Bunkier Sztuki Museum of Contemporary Art in Krakow.



She also participated in invitational conferences from European universities (including the Women's Leadership Symposium at Oxford). Her scientific research and creative work refer to female artistic perception and are based on an interest in intimacy and the female body.

She speaks 4 languages fluently. She is a young professional with extensive artistic experience. Her works show a high intellectual and creative level.
